INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION PLACEMENT PRINCIPLES

- 1) The applications of international student candidates who apply within the framework of "Eskişehir Osmangazi University International Student Application, Admission and Registration Directive" are admitted through the online preference management system made available during the application period announced on the website of the International Student Admission and Registration Coordinatorship (https://student.ogu.edu.tr, https://student.ogu.edu.tr/en).
- 2) Applications for placements are made with the scores of the exam types specified in Table 1.
- 3) International student candidates can apply to a maximum of 5 departments/programs and will be placed in only one department/program. The international student placed in a department/program will not be horizontally transferred to another program.
- 4) The candidate must meet the minimum score requirement in the examination types indicated in Table 1 and the National Diploma/High School Completion Examinations specified in Table 2 in order to be admitted to a department/program.
- 5) The scores of candidates who meet the application requirements and fulfill the placement conditions are converted to a percentile scale, with a maximum score of 100, and ranked accordingly.
- 6) In the case of equal examination scores among applicants for placement in available positions, priority is given to those with higher secondary education (high school) diploma grades. If the equality persists, the age of the applicants is taken into consideration, with priority given to the younger ones. In the case of equal age, the preference order of the candidates is examined. If the equality still persists, priority is given to the candidate who graduated from secondary education (high school) more recently.
- 7) In the main placement and the placement for the remaining 1st vacant quota period, the number of candidates from the same country who are granted admission rights cannot exceed 20% of the total quota of the respective program. If the quotas are not filled, candidates are placed in the unfilled quotas according to their examination scores, without considering this rule. However, the provision stated in Article 9 is reserved for the 1st education (daytime) programs. For placements and additional placements in 2nd education programs, the country quota restriction does not apply.
- 8) The University Senate has the authority to impose restrictions on admissions of international students based on nationality for the specified academic year.
- 9) According to Article A, Paragraph 2, Subsection (c) of the Principles Regarding the Admission of International Students by the Council of Higher Education Presidency, a 10% quota restriction is applied to the faculties of Medicine, Dentistry, Law, and Education for candidates who have the opportunity to apply for admission quotas from abroad, candidates who were Turkish citizens by birth according to the Turkish Citizenship Law but have lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission from the Ministry of Interior Affairs to renounce their

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Turkish citizenship, candidates who can provide evidence of holding a blue card, candidates who are Turkish citizens and have completed their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country (except the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (KKTC)), and have dual citizenship with one of them being Turkish citizenship. In the main placement, if the aforementioned 10% quota is filled, those who are not registered or those who are within the scope of this limitation cannot be placed in the additional placements to be made to the vacant quotas.

- 10) In the main placement and the placement for the remaining 1st vacant quota period, the placements are made based on the examination scores specified in Table 1, taking into account the superiority of scores among students who have a valid examination score for application. The evaluation of applications of candidates who apply for these terms is carried out through the system by the International Student Admission and Registration Coordinator or member(s) of the International Student Admission and Registration Committee, among candidates who meet the placement condition stated in Article 4. Applications of candidates who are found not to meet the application requirements and placement conditions during the preliminary review of online applications are not considered for evaluation.
- 11) The student who has been granted the right to register does not have the right to reapply and make preferences, even if he/she fails to enroll in the program they have been placed into, in case vacant quotas are announced during the same academic year.
- 12) If an international student applicant fails to pay the first semester tuition fees and complete the online registration within the specified dates of the application period, they will forfeit their right to registration.
- 13) Applications of candidates who provide false information or deceive the administration through any action or transaction will be rejected. If such candidates' registrations have already been completed, they will be canceled, and their affiliation with the university will be terminated.
- 14) After the registration period of the 1st vacant quota placement period, which takes place for the vacancies after the main placement period, if vacancies still persist, additional placements are made among reserve candidates who are determined among the applicants of this round based on their ranking in terms of scores. The additional placement is carried out among the applicants who have not been placed in any department/program, based on their score superiority. In these placements, in accordance with the decision of the International Student Admission and Registration Commission, placements may be made in the 1st education programs without being subject to the quota limitations of Article 7, while Article 9 provisions apply.
- 15) If the University Board of Directors decides to make placements for the vacancies that remain after the 1st vacant quota period, the main placement period, new application periods can be opened.
- 16) If a new application period is opened for the vacancies that remain after the 1st vacant quota period, the main placement period, the placements will be made among candidates who meet the placement condition specified in Article 4, within the framework mentioned in Article 10.

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In these placements, placements can be made without being restricted by the quota limitations of Article 7.

- 17) Acceptance letters for international student candidates, regarding their placement in the department/program, are signed by the International Student Admission and Registration Coordinator and presented through the online preference management system.
- 18) Acceptance letters for international student candidates regarding their placement in the department/program will be made available on the website of the International Student Admission and Registration Coordinator on the date specified in the calendar. The access to acceptance letters will be closed after the registration deadline of the respective period.
- 19) Students who wish to apply for programs that admit students through special talent exams are required to participate in the talent exams conducted by the Faculty of Arts and Design.
- 20) Students who have completed online registration are required to hand in the necessary documents to the International Student Admission and Registration Coordinatorship for final registration in person or by individuals with notarized power of attorney, within the dates specified on the university's International Student Admission and Registration Coordinator's website (https://student.ogu.edu.tr, https://student.ogu.edu.tr/en). (Those who will register with a power of attorney must have their power of attorney endorsed with an Apostille or certified by the Turkish Consulate in their country.) Registration by mail is not accepted, and incomplete documentation will not be processed for registration. Failure to submit the required documents within the registration period will result in the cancellation of the student's registration.
